



Basic Camping Checklist

Whether you keep things simple or go all out, this checklist will help you avoid missing any necessities so you can focus on the fun.

Camp Setup

- Tent
- Mallet or hammer for pounding in the tent stakes
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Sleeping pads or blowup mattress
- Folding table (if a picnic table is not available)
- Big Green Egg folding chairs
- Big Green Egg canopy (for covering the chef in case of rain)
- Headlamps, lanterns or flashlights
- Firewood and fire starters
- Multi-tool

Personal Items

* For a greener camping trip, opt for reusable cups, plates and silverware; if you use disposable, look for products that are biodegradable or recyclable. If using reusable products, bring a plastic tub for storing the dirty dishes until you get home. Make sure you bring a separate trash bag for recycling cans and water bottles.
